Sections:

In City Rates

13.01.10 Water and Sewer Monthly Rates have been amended as follows:

- A. \$17.15 (minimum) First 2000 Gallons
- B. \$ 4.42 per 1000 gallons next 3000 Gallons
- C. \$ 3.82 per 1000 gallons next 5000 Gallons
- D. \$ 3.55 per 1000 gallons all over 10000 Gallons

Out of City Rates

- E. \$17.71 (minimum) First 2000 Gallons
- F. \$ 4.72 per 1000 gallons next 3000 Gallons
- G. \$ 4.41 per 1000 gallons next 5000 Gallons
- H. \$ 4.31 per 1000 gallons all over 10000 Gallons
- I. Wholesale water rate \$1.95 per 1000 Gallons

Sewer Rates

13.02.10 Sewer Rates have been amended as follows:

- A. The monthly charge for wastewater shall remain 100% of water charge.

Surcharge

13.03 Surcharge Rates have been amended as follows:

- A. A \$1.00 Surcharge shall be implemented for all water users.

Tap on Fees

13.03.10 Tap on Fees have been amended as follows:

Water Tap on City Fees

- A. ¾ inch meter \$ 700
B. 1 inch meter \$ 900
C. 2 inch meter \$2000

Water Tap Out of City Rates

- D. ¾ inch meter \$1000
E. 1 inch meter \$1200
F. 2 inch meter \$2300

Sewer Tap

- G. \$400 Fee
H. Said water and sewer connections shall be payable in full before the connection is made.

13.03.20 Applicability of Rates and Charges

The rates and charges as established in Section 13.04.10 shall apply to all residential, commercial and other establishments in any manner directly or indirectly with the water and sewer system of the city. (Ord. Dated 5/8/73)

13.03.30 Billing, Penalty, and Payment Dates

- A. All bills shall be rendered monthly and shall be due upon receipt.
B. Bills shall be payable without penalty if paid by the 15th of month.
C. On the 16th day of the month a ten percent penalty shall be added to the bills.
D. Whenever rates and charges remain unpaid for fifteen days after the first of the month, the users of the services and facilities shall be delinquent until all rates and charges are paid in full.
E. The city shall, after giving at least twenty-four (24) hours notice shut off and discontinue water service to any delinquent customers until all delinquent charges, plus penalty, plus reconnection fee (\$25.00) have been paid in full.

- F. The City Clerk shall render the bills, the same shall be collected and accounted for in the manner prescribed by law and the proceedings pursuant to which the City's water and sewer revenue bond was issued.

13.04.40 Free Service Prohibited

No free services shall be allowed or permitted from the water and sewer system, and no permanent connections to the system shall be permitted or made except on a metered basis. (Ord. Dated 5/8/73)

13.03.50 Sewer Connections Outside City Limits

No connection to sanitary sewer lines owned, operated, or maintained by the City shall be permitted outside of city limits unless the owner(s) of the real property to which sanitary sewer service is to be provided (hereinafter the "subject property") shall first enter into an agreement with the city providing that the owners grant their consent to, and will not oppose, the annexation of the subject property into the city limits, all on such form of agreement as may be prescribed by the City. (Ord. 304, 1994.)

13.03.60 Extensions to Water and Sewer Systems

- A. Any extension to the present New Haven Water System shall be approved by the Board of Commissioners. Waterline plans and specifications are to be drawn up by a certified engineer. If the City agrees to the requested waterline extension, the plans for the said extension must be submitted to the Division of Water. All state requirements have to be met before the extension is initiated. The property owner (applicant) shall incur all costs subject to waterline extension. The line will be inspected by the Water and Sewer Superintendent. If the line meets all requirements and specifications of the City, the City will accept ownership of said line one year after completion. The connection fee for water hookons shall apply and shall be paid before actual connection to the City system.
- B. Any extension to the present New Haven sewer system shall first be approved by the Board of Commissioners. Sewerline profile, plans, and specifications are to be drawn up by a certified engineer. If the City agrees to the requested sewerline extension, the plans for the extension must be submitted to the Division of Water. All state requirements will have to be met before the extension is initiated. The property owner (applicant) shall incur all costs subject to sewerline extension. The line will be inspected by the Water and Sewer Superintendent. If the line meets all requirements and specifications of the City, the City will accept ownership of said line one year after completion. The connection fee for sewer hookons shall apply and shall be paid before actual connection to the city system. (Ord. 176, 1991)
